"You feel like you're on a freadmill... but you're not going anywhere."

Today, Julia is on a path to a new beginning – and her heart is filled with gratitude for friends like you who are making her journey possible.

Julia has faced a lot of difficult moments in her life: trying to heal from abuse that caused lasting physical and emotional damage... recovering from an addiction to alcohol that had helped her cope with that abuse.

But when she found herself in the ICU, her body weakened from illness, Julia didn't know how to move forward.

Just months earlier, she'd finally left her abusive relationship. "It was the grace of God that got me out," she says. "I had other people supporting me, helping me... and I was finally able to walk away."

To make ends meet, she moved into an apartment with her adult son. But when he lost his job, they lost their apartment. 'I stayed at a hotel, searching for more affordable apartments. But my wages just barely covered each week at the hotel.'

Her health grew worse... and when she went to the hospital, doctors thought her heart might not survive her weakened state.

Three days later, Julia left the hospital with just \$10 in her pocket. 'I had nowhere to go,' she remembers. And in addition to recovering physically, she was also suffering emotionally and spiritually.

A kind-hearted case worker at the hospital told Julia about our Center for Women & Children and she decided to give it a try. She was overwhelmed by the warmth and welcome of our staff – and through the counseling, classes and spiritual guidance here, Julia experienced true healing for the first time in her life.

Wheeler showed me there's a light at the end of the tunnel.

Today, when Julia looks in the mirror, she finally sees a woman she recognizes. 'I didn't know if I was ever going to find 'me' again,' she says. 'I'm still a work in progress, but I'm so much more myself.'

She's now saving up money for a new apartment, working full-time and looking forward to a brighter, more stable future on her own. Most of all, she's thankful for the love she's felt every day at Wheeler. *"I was a seriously broken woman when I got here. Today, I'm a different person."*
