She was doing well for years, working hard at her job and taking care of her ailing mother, physically and financially. I'd been sober for 12 years, but I relapsed and ended up homeless, scared, lonely, and hopeless."

Thankfully, she knew she could find help and hope at Wheeler Mission, so she entered our Higher Ground addiction recovery program for women. Since then, Julie's faith has grown stronger through Bible studies and fellowship, and she's processed her pain through Christ-centered counseling and life skills

classes. "I looked inside and identified the feelings that were making me angry," she says.

Her daughter is overjoyed at her transformation, and Julie is working to restore her other family relationships as well. "I've learned that God forgives me and accepts me no matter what, and now I'm seeking others' forgiveness and learning to forgive myself."
